OPW 38-C (0038), 38-CS (0380) CO-AXIAL ADAPTORS

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The OPW 38-C & 38-CS Co-Axial Adaptors are shipped from the factory ready for mounting connection to the vapor line, product line and the co-axial hose. No adjustments are necessary before installation.

INSTALLATION:

- · Mount the adaptor (flanges are pre-drilled).
- Apply pipe sealant to the male thread of the fuel line. (Do not use plastic tape.)
 Install and tighten the fuel line into the inlet marked "Fuel" (3/4 female NPT).
 Do not overtighten or casting may crack resulting in an unsafe condition.
- Install and tighten the vapor line in the same manner. (3/4 female NPT.) (marked "Vapor".)
- Connect the co-axial hose to the outlet of the adaptor. Care must be exercised not to damage or dislodge the two (2) seal rings inside the fuel passage. Tighten the hose nut to 50-75 foot-pounds torque. Pipe sealant is not necessary on the threads. (Do not use plastic tape.)

WARNING: Special attention must be given to these connections to be sure that the fuel line is connected to the side marked FUEL and the vapor line is connected to the side marked VAPOR. Failure to connect the line to the proper inlet will result in spillage when the pumping system is turned on.

Nozzle, adaptor, and hose assembly must be tested for proper operation on your dispensing system prior to putting into service.

WARNING:


