Product Description

The primary function of the Pressure/Vacuum (PV) vent is to control the pressure and vacuum condition of the tank during operation. The vent is designed to relieve (pop-off) pressure or vacuum due to temperature changes at specified settings. The device is designed with a roll-over shut off feature to seal the tank in an overturn condition. In addition, the vent is standard with a filter/flame arrestor





Manual

The manual contains the inspection, maintenance schedule, and instructions for repairing and replacing parts for all NV3000 Pressure/Vacuum Vents. The following schedule, based on the environmental conditions in the northern United States, is only a recommendation: *Inspection and maintenance intervals must be adjusted according to use and operating conditions*. If any parts are damaged, refer to the *Product Maintenance* section.

Installation Procedure

- 1. Remove Existing Vent
- 2. Apply anti-seize compound to the threads of the new vent
- 3. Install new vent and hand tighten
- 4. Using pliers or a wrench, tighten the vent 1/4" to 1/2" turn.

Do not tighten vent body on the sides where the vacuum poppets are located.

This may cause damage to the vent.

Product Maintenance

This vent may require maintenance every six months to ensure proper maintenance. If vent is operating in a dirty environment or more aggressive liquids, more frequent maintenance will be required. Test the vent to verify that it is sealing properly. If it is not functioning properly, disassemble vent and clean filter/flame arrestor (7), o-rings (14, 15, 16, and 17), and sealing surfaces with warm soapy water. This device is designed to allow for quick removal of the working portion of the vent from the fill cover. Simply press and rotate the vent counterclockwise and separate the body from the top enclosure. O-rings should be inspected for cuts, swelling, or deterioration. If any of these conditions are found, seals should be replaced. Inspect seal surface s for scratches or other damage that may lead to improper sealing. If these conditions exist, replace the vent.

CAUTION: The filter/flame arrestor must be cleaned periodically for safe operation.
