OPW 5-B AND 5-BP SPOUT ASSEMBLY REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS


The 5-B Spout Assembly is the replacement spout assembly for OPW 11-A Series Automatic Nozzles, for use with leaded gasoline. The 5-BP small diameter (13/16") spout assembly is the replacement spout assembly for OPW 11-AP Series Automatic Nozzles, for use with unleaded gasoline.


CAUTION: FOLLOW THESE STEPS EXACTLY FOR EASY SPOUT REPLACEMENT

NOTE: DO NOT USE WITH 11-B SERIES NOZZLE

- 1. Remove plastic fender guard. Save for reuse later.
- 2. Remove spout retaining screw from the underside of nozzle near spout end, and pull the old spout assembly out of the nozzle. Also remove the old seal rings. Throw the old parts away. Be sure there is no dirt or foreign matter in the outlet end of nozzle.
- 3. Remove tape from the new spout assembly, and coat both seal rings with a heavy lubricating oil. Remove the spout retaining screw.
- 4. Place both seal rings on the spout assembly as shown in Fig. 1.
- 5. Insert the new spout assembly gently, but firmly, into the outlet end of the nozzle with a slight twisting motion until it will go no farther. Rotate the spout until the retaining screw hole in the adaptor is in line with the screw hole in the nozzle.
- 6. Insert spout retaining screw and tighten firmly. Replace plastic fender guard.
- 7. Test nozzle for shut-off in all clip positions. Remove nozzle from service if it fails to shut-off.

IT IS IMPORTANT THAT THE O-RINGS ARE LUBRICATED AND THAT THE SPOUT IS INSERTED WITH A GENTLE BUT FIRM SLIGHT TWISTING MOTION. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS MAY DAMAGE THE O-RINGS AND RESULT IN NOZZLE FAILURE.








