
VAPOR RECOVERY SINGLE USE BREAKAWAY MODEL 66CSU

The 66CSU separates at pounds maximum pull force. *PRIOR TO INSTALLATION*, it shall be determined that such pull force will not damage hose assembly of dispensing device.

To determine if hose assembly and dispensing will withstand the required pull force, follow this procedure:

Attach a spring scale (NOTE: an adapter to engage the hook of spring scale should first be threaded onto hose fitting) to the end of hose assembly and pull in a straight line (as illustration A) the required 250 pounds maximum pull force. Repeat this procedure, pulling the hose as straight as possible at 45 degree intervals both to the right and left of the dispenser (as illustration B), and again repeat the procedure pulling the hose around dispensing cabinet (as in illustration C).


If hose assembly and dispensing device withstand the required 250 pounds maximum pull force, proceed with installation as instructed.




INSTALLATION

- 1. Do not use Teflon Tape, use U.L. Listed Thread Sealant.
- 2. Wrench on Hex/Flat areas only. (Caution: See illustration on reverse side).
- 3. Installation: 66CSU MUST be installed with Flow Arrow Pointing toward nozzle.
- A. On dispensers with overhead hose connection (illustration A), install Model 66CSU with a minimum of 10 inches of hose connected to dispenser outlet, as shown.
- B. On dispenser with side hose connection (illustration B), install Model 66CSU with a minimum of 10 inches of hose connected between the breakaway and nozzle as shown.

WARNING

- 1. Hose could be caught on vehicle resulting in direct pull on retractor cable or pump, bypassing breakaway.
- 2. Pump dispenser cabinet must be bolted down securely.
